



SPAY/NEUTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

This program applies only to animals that meet the following criteria

- Adopted from Walker County Animal Shelter, or
- Owned by residents of Walker County, Georgia

What is the Program?

- The purpose of this program is to assist pet owners with the cost of having their pets spayed or neutered
- This assistance takes the form of a **\$35.00** rebate check for the cost of the sterilization procedure only
- Procedures less than **\$35.00** are reimbursed at **100%**
- **Only procedures performed at full cost vets and clinics will be considered at this time**
- **The program is funded solely by donations and funds may limit the number of rebates issued**

How does the program work?

It's actually quite simple. After your pet is spayed or neutered, follow these steps to apply for a rebate

- Complete the official application form
- Enclose a COPY of the original Vet invoice
- Mail the application and copy of invoice to:

Your application and invoice copy will be reviewed, and if accepted, your rebate check will be mailed in 6 to 8 weeks

Vet invoices must be COPIES.

- Invoices must be kept for our records and will not be returned
- Applications without the required copy of Vet invoice will be rejected and returned

Please submit applications within 60 days of the surgery.

How long will the program last?

- NGAL is determined to maintain this program as long as it is financially able to do so

North Georgia Animal League is the sole governing body of the Spay/Neuter Rebate Program, and as such, determines the duration of this program and may terminate, modify, or suspend this program without notice or cause.
